Bio: Ms. Garrett is the only writer to have been awarded all three of the Big “P”s of journalism: the Peabody, Polk, and Pulitzer. Her expertise includes global health systems, chronic and infectious diseases, and bioterrorism. Ms. Garrett’s latest book is *I Heard the Sirens Scream: How Americans Responded to the 9/11 and Anthrax Attacks*. She previously worked at National Public Radio and *Newsday*, and has done freelance reporting for Pacifica Radio, Pacific News Service, BBC Radio, Reuters, and the Associated Press. She has written for many publications, including *Foreign Affairs*, *Esquire*, *Vanity Fair*, *Los Angeles Times*, *Washington Post*, and *Current Issues in Public Health*. Ms. Garrett has appeared frequently on national television programs, including ABC’s *Nightline*, *News-Hour with Jim Lehrer*, *Charlie Rose Show*, *Oprah Winfrey Show*, and *Dateline*.
